

Order of Worship March 28th, 2024

The Thursday of Holy Week may derive its name from the command Christ gave His followers to love one another (John 13.34) and "to wash" (Latin mundo), referring to Christ's washing the feet of the apostles. As the remembrance (Latin Mandatum, meaning mandate; i.e., "Do this in remembrance of me") of our Lord's institution of the Last Supper, Maundy Thursday is almost universally celebrated with the Lord's Table.
