The Community Health Program integrates specially trained prehospital professionals with an expanded role, who will assist with closing healthcare gaps and improving access while decreasing healthcare costs.


- **Frequent Falls** The program seeks to mitigate fall risks by performing in-home safety assessments and fall prevention education.
- **Mental Health / Substance Abuse** The program seeks to identify patients that would be better served outside the emergency room setting and redirect these individuals to the appropriate community resource(s).
- **Diabetic Patients** The program seeks to provide nutritional and disease management education to diabetic patients to prevent unnecessary Emergency Department / EMS utilization.
- Congestive Heart Failure / Chronic Respiratory Conditions -Ensuring proper medication compliance, nutrition, and education on disease management for patients who are diagnosed with congestive heart failure or other Chronic respiratory conditions.
- **High System Utilizers** The Community Health program seeks to include all patients that are high utilizers of the 911 system and Emergency Department, by providing education and aligning the patient's with primary care resources available within the community.
